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RIOJA ALAVESA WINES

Igor González Ayala, a native of Laguardia in Rioja Alavesa, decided to showcase the value of his family's old vineyards by establishing the González Ayala winery in 2019. H

is vision is to create wines that authentically reflect the origin, characteristics, and personality of the vineyards located in the Riojanoalavesa towns of Lanciego and Laguardia.

These wines are crafted in an artisanal manner, aiming to evoke the essence of the vineyards from which they originate and preserve the distinct character of each one.

The philosophy of González Ayala winery revolves around conserving the natural and cultural heritage inherent in its vineyards. They aim to enhance varietal diversity and craft distinctive wines that showcase the value of their village vineyards.

Key to this approach is the integration of trees, aromatic plants, stone walls, and vegetative cover within their vineyards.

The orientation of the vines and their proximity to the Laguardia Lagoon complex play crucial roles in fostering biodiversity.

Together with the unique soil compositions and microclimates of each plot, these factors ensure that the wines express the distinctive qualities of their terroir to the fullest extent.

VIÑEDOS DE LAGUARDIA
(RED)

Our Tinto Viñedos de Laguardia red wine seeks to express the characteristics of Laguardia’s mature vines. The grapes used in their production originate from the San Lázaro (30% of the total), Valcavada (60%) and Río Hondillo (10%) vineyards.

The fruit from these vineyards is fermented and aged separately prior to coupage.

TASTING NOTES

This is a full-bodied wine which has a good balance of fruit flavours and those associated with oak barrel ageing.

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WHITE WINE

This wine aims to embody the essence of white grape varieties found in the mature vineyards of Rioja Alavesa.

Within these vineyards, both white and red grapes coexist, with the white varieties predominantly growing at the top of the vines.

The primary grapes include Viura, complemented by Malvasía Riojana and Calagraño, their proportions varying by vineyard.

TASTING NOTES

This white wine offers floral and ripe fruit aromas, reflecting its varietal composition.

On the palate, it is refreshingly crisp yet generously full-bodied, striking a perfect balance between its vibrant acidity and ample fruit character.

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VIÑEDOS DE LANCIEGO (RED)

Our Viñedos de Lanciego red wine seeks to express the characteristics of Lanciego’s mature vines.

The wine comes from the La Pedrera vineyard to the south east of the village.

This is a wine that stands out for its volume and body with black- and red-fruit aromas and flavours in which its time in the barrel is not particularly noteworthy.

The vintage is characterised by the hailstorms that hit the vineyard in June, reducing the fruit yield.

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EL CERRO DE REDONDILLO
(RED)

El Cerro de Redondillo seeks to celebrate the distinctiveness of its vineyard, where vines dating back to 1925 thrive amidst sandstone layers, their roots reaching deep into the soil.

Emphasizing strict environmental stewardship and biodiversity preservation, this wine embodies a commitment to sustainability.

It presents as a full-bodied and voluminous wine, distinguished by its aromas and flavors of black and red fruits, intertwined with subtle notes of aromatic herbs.
